Bhartiya Reserve Bank Note Mudran Pvt Ltd was founded by the Reserve Bank of India as its wholly owned subsidiary on 3rd February, 1995. The purpose of the establishment of BRBNMPL was the production of bank notes in India to enable the RBI to bridge the gap between the supply and demand for bank notes in the country. BRBNMPL manages 2 presses – one at Mysore, Karnataka and the other

at Salboni, West Bengal. The present capacity for both presses is 16billion note pieces per year on a 2-shift basis.

Out of these two presses, Salboni press is situated in Salboni township where the government has built quarters for the press workers and RBI employees, amongst others, where they can live with their families. Many facilities have been provided for the families such as schools, markets, movie halls, a stadium and play areas. Altius Sports has done two woodenvinyl indoor badminton courts in this BRBNMPL's Salboni township area, accessible to BRBNMPL's employees and their family members only. Here we have installed BWF-certified wooden flooring on a concrete base with a 4.5 mm vinyl surface.
